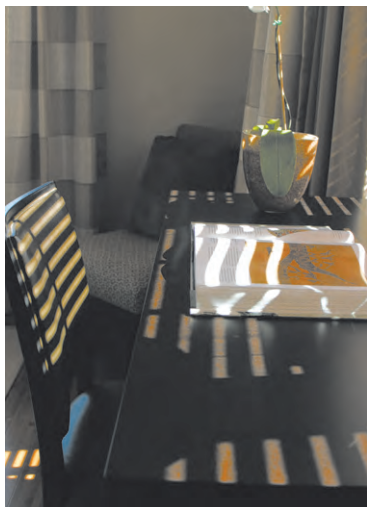


A Discreet Retreat
